
Lecture topic:

Rediscovery of the Elements – Tracking down the original discovery sites of the mines and laboratories for all of the elements

Presenter: Dr. James L. Marshall

Professor Emeritus, Department of Chemistry, University of North Texas Denton, Texas

<u>Abstract:</u> It is the International Year of the Periodic Table of Chemical Elements (IYPT 2019)! Just in time, the final edition of "Rediscovery of the Elements" has been completed. This project was the team effort of Jim and Jenny Marshall, who have traveled to all the discovery sites of the elements. These sites include the laboratories (universities, pharmacies, private homes) where the chemical



analyses were performed, as well as the original source of the elements (mines, quarries, etc.). In his presentation Dr. Marshall will present stories of what it was like to journey through 28 countries to track down, identify, and document all of these historic locations.

About the Speaker: Dr. Jim Marshall joined the University of North Texas in 1967, spending 52 years there with an interim appointment at Motorola in Ft. Worth. His research interests have included nuclear magnetic resonance, materials science, and the history of chemistry. He has been a member of the ACS Speaker Tour program for many years, and has been invited to speak at numerous meetings on a broad range of topics. Beginning in 1998, he and his wife Jenny have carried out the "Rediscovery of the Elements" project. In this research effort the team personally tracked down and visited all the discovery sites of the elements, and have developed a multi-volume "Living Travelogue" for the general scientific public.
